

Request to School Tour Guides

Thank you for your cooperation with the Kyushu National Museum management. **Recently, there were many cases of school tour groups violating museum rules.** We seek the assistance of tour guides to contact the museum regarding school visits in advance and to also remind the students of appropriate behaviour inside the museum.

< Prohibited Acts >



Please do not eat or drink in the museum (including sweets or chewing gum). Excluding designated areas (open café).



Do not touch the museum exhibits.

Excluding selected exhibits located in Cultural Exchange Exhibition on the 4th Floor.

Do not touch the glass of the display cases.

Do not put items on the display cases.



No running in the museum.

No playing on the escalators.



Photography or video recording is strictly prohibited in the exhibition rooms.

Includes all devices with recording function (smart phones and tablets).



Please either turn off mobile devices or switch on silent mode, and refrain from using them in the museum.



Please speak softly in the museum.



Please be considerate to other visitors by making as little noise as possible with your shoes.



Only pencils and mechanical pencils can be used in the exhibition rooms.

Fountain pens or ballpoint pens (pens that use ink) are prohibited.

Please note that the use of pencils may also be prohibited in selected Special Exhibition rooms.

Visitors who violate the rules written above may be asked to leave the museum premises.

[Points to note]

- Please leave the umbrellas in the umbrella stand located on the 1st Floor outside the museum. For foldable umbrellas, please fold it and place it inside your bag.
- The Museum does not make announcements for tour groups. Please decide on the meeting time before entering the exhibition rooms.
- Please be considerate of other visitors when meeting up with your tour group. You may approach the museum staff for help. Please do not gather at the entrance of the exhibition rooms on the 3rd and 4th Floors as the space is limited.
- A maximum of 70 visitors are allowed inside Ajippa located on the 1st Floor. While reservations are not required, the number of people entering Ajippa may be controlled for tour groups.
