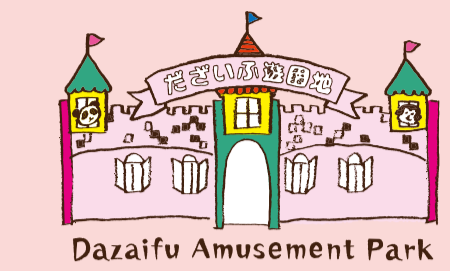

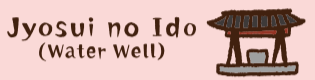

Kyushu National Museum, opened in 2005, is the fourth national museum in Japan. The Cultural Exchange Exhibition introduces Japan's history of cultural exchange with Asia and Europe using audio guides and text descriptions in multiple languages (English, Chinese, and Korean) so foreign visitors can enjoy their visit at the museum.
